The master chef's other signature dishes are King Prawn Jai Ho, a unique dish created for the restaurant, and chef's personal recommendation, Sabka Maza. Made with chicken, lamb or beef as per the diner's preference, the meat is gently cooked with garlic, ginger, onions, tomatoes, green chilli and hot spices, all combining to produce a fresh and extremely distinctive flavour.
